**SECOND AMENDMENT TO
COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS OF
GLEN LAUREL**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS OF GLEN LAUREL is made this 4th day of May, 1999, by and between GLEN LAUREL HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC., a not-for-profit Florida corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Association"), and Glen Laurel, Inc., a Florida corporation, whose address is Suite E, 1730 Kingsley Avenue, Orange Park, Florida, 32073 (hereinafter referred to as "Glen Laurel").

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, Glen Laurel has caused to be recorded Covenants and Restrictions of Glen Laurel as recorded on July 14, 1998, in Official Records Book 1731, page 1459, and as amended by First Amendment to Covenants and Restrictions of Glen Laurel recorded December 15, 1998, in Official Records Book 1762, page 693, all of the public records of Clay County, Florida (the covenants and restrictions are herein referred to as the "Covenants", and the lands heretofore affected by the Covenants are herein referred to as "Units One and Two"). Units One and Two are the same lands described in and the subject of that certain Plat of Glen Laurel Units One and Two as recorded in Plat Book 31, pages 52 through 59, inclusive, of the public records of Clay County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Association is a not-for-profit Florida corporation comprised of the owners of lots in Units One and Two, and the Association desires to assume additional burdens and benefits with respect to Units Three and Four of Glen Laurel, being those lands described in and the subject of those certain Plats of Glen Laurel Units Three and Four (herein "Units Three and Four", respectively) as recorded in Plat Book 32, pages 37 through 43, inclusive, of the public records of Clay County, Florida.

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
