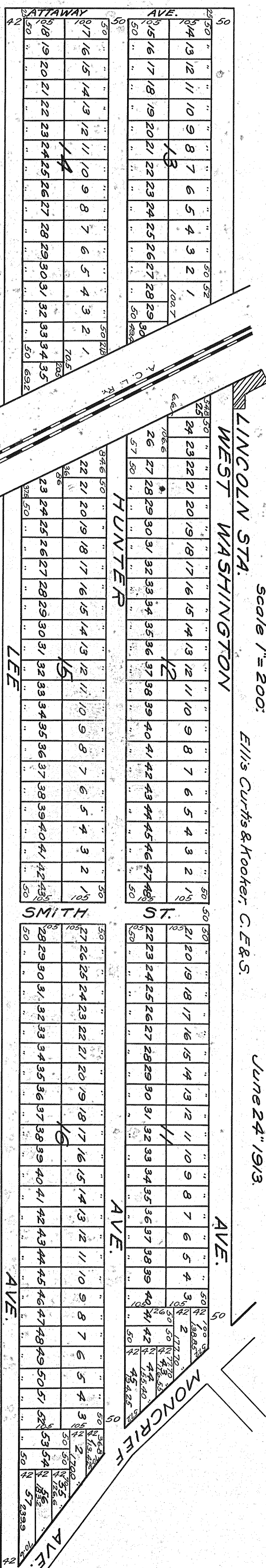


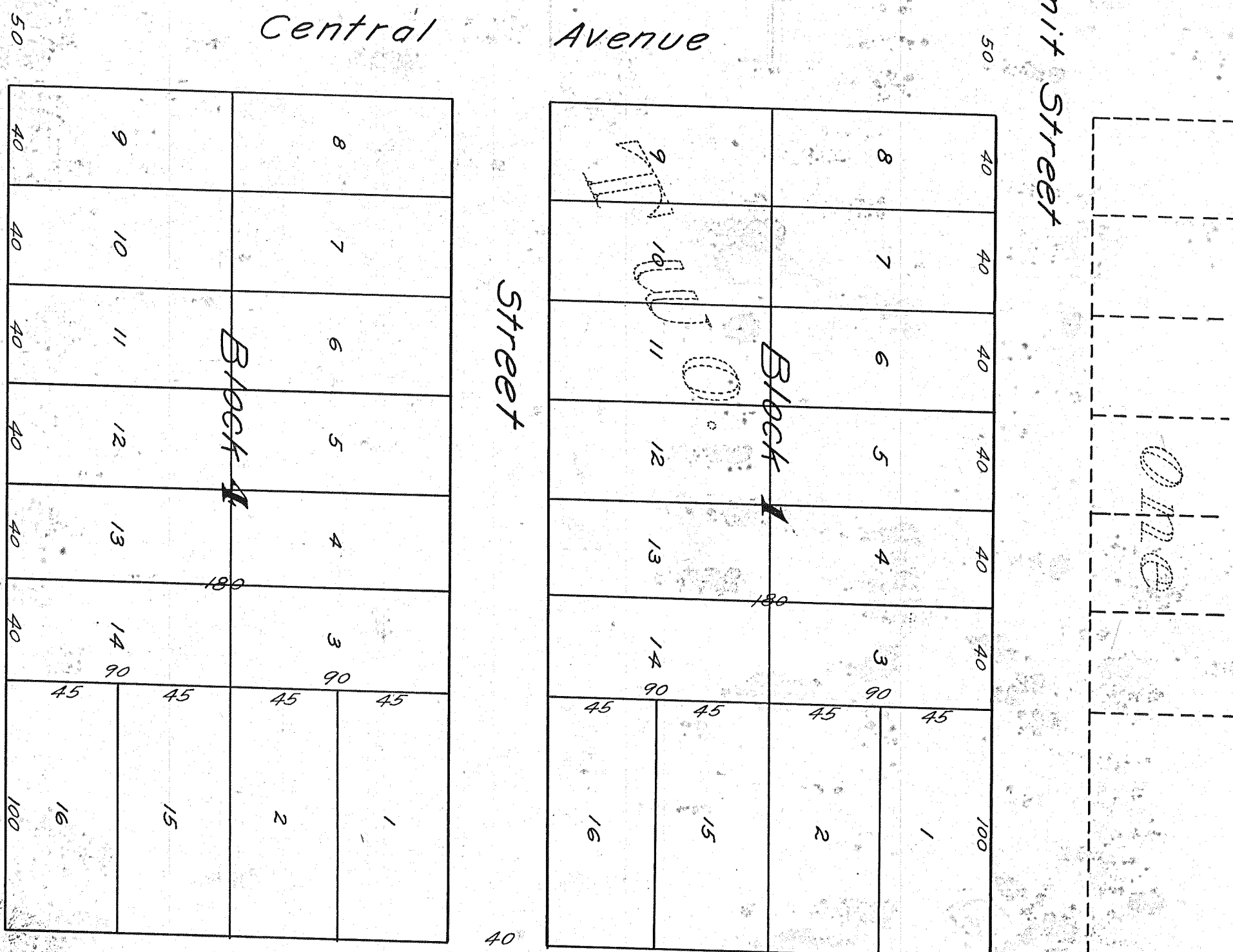
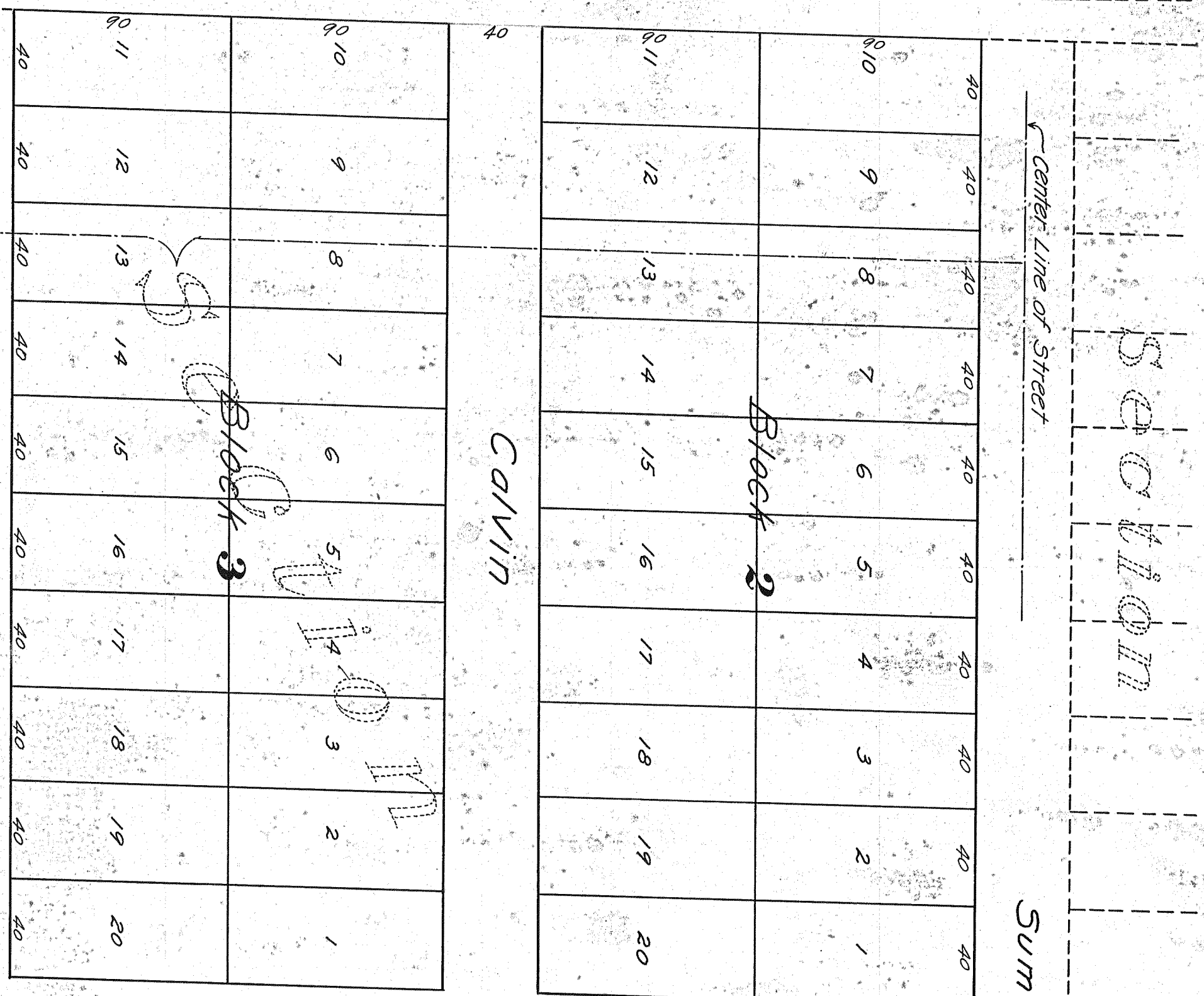
LINCOLN VILLAS

Scale 1" = 200'. Ellis Curtis & Hooker, C.E. & S. June 24 1913.



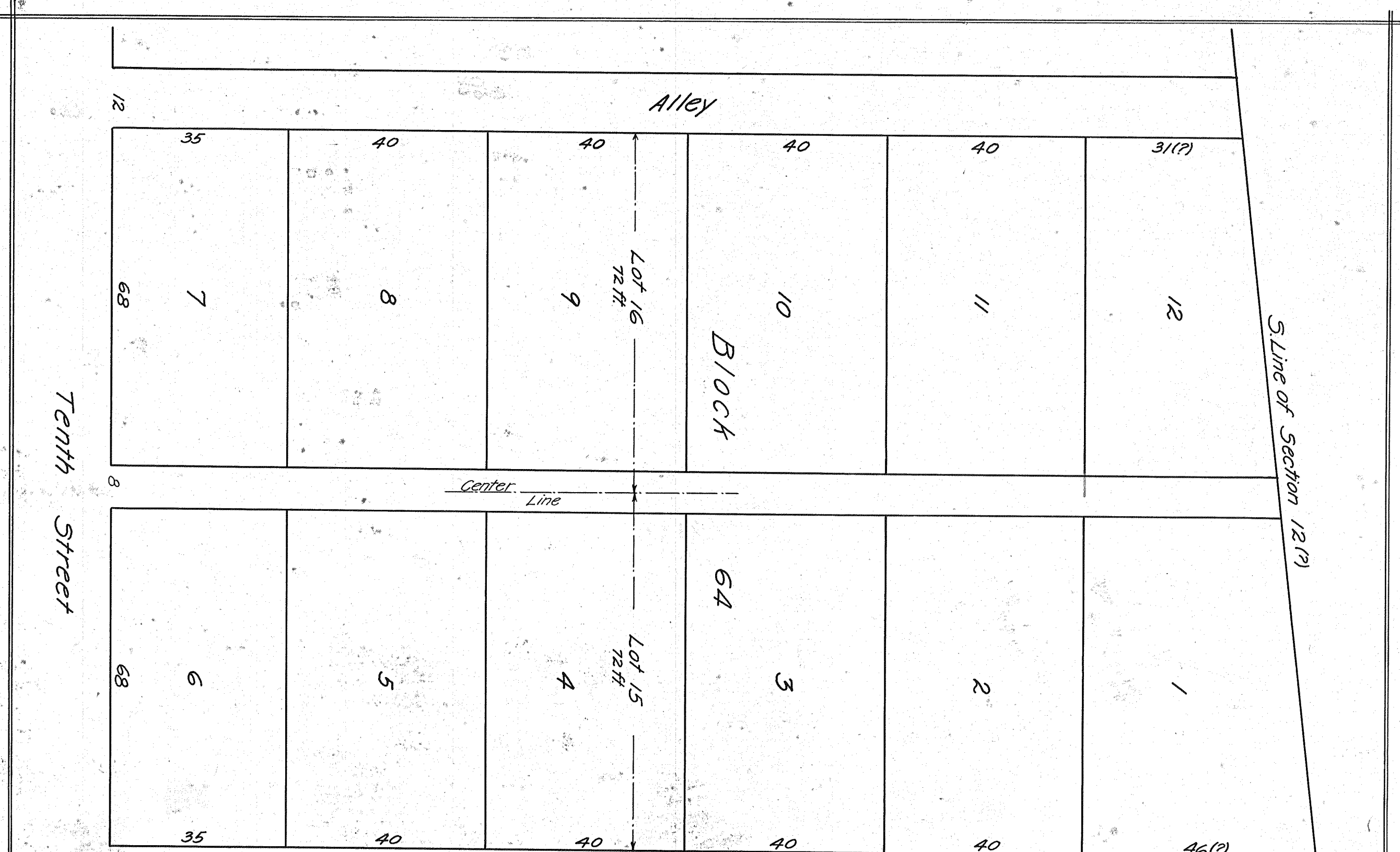
