A PORTION OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA.

CAPTION

A portion of the South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 32, Township 3 South, Range 27 East, City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows: COMMENCE at the Southeast corner of the South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 32, said Southeast corner is also situate on the Northerly boundary line of Huntington Forest Unit Two, as recorded in Plat Book 35, Pages 9 and 9A, of the current Public Records of said County; thence run North 89°35'39" West, along said Northerly boundary, 906.05 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continue, North 89°35'39" West, along last said line, 411.00 feet to the Northwesterly corner of the aforementioned plat of Huntington Forest Unit Two; thence South 89°38'56" West, departing from the boundary of said Huntington Forest Unit Two, 241.30 feet; thence North 43°02'02" East, 253.52 feet to a point situate on a curve leading to the left; thence along and around the arc of the curve, said curve being concave Northeasterly and having a radius of 125.07 feet, an arc length of 77.65 feet, said arc being subtended by a chord bearing and distance of South 71°48'25" East, 76.41 feet to a point of tangency; thence South 89°35'39" East, 27.20 feet; thence North 00°24'21" East, 30.08 feet; thence North 37°25'54" East, 106.37 feet; thence North 77°06'44 East, 70.39 feet; thence North 64°44'36" East, 110.00 feet; thence North 68°58'33" East, 138.00 feet; thence South 89°56'50" East, 59.84 feet; thence South 00°24'21" West, 110.58 feet to a point situate on a curve leading to the left; thence along and around the arc of the curve, said curve being concave Southeasterly and having a radius of 319.08 feet, an arc length of 98.18 feet, said arc being subtended by a chord bearing and distance of South 79°24'23" West, 97.80 feet to a point on said curve; thence South 57°04'44" East, departing from said curve, 67.15 feet; thence South 00°24'21" West, 224.29 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

ADOPTION AND DEDICATION

This is to certify that D. W. Hutson Construction, Inc., and Sing Oil Company, a Georgia Corporation, Joint Venture, doing business as Hutson-Sing Joint Venture IV, are the lawful owners of the lands described in the Caption hereon known as CYPRESS HAMMOCK unit four, and have caused the same to be surveyed and subdivided; that the BARNETT BANK of JACKSONVILLE, NA, is the holder of the mortgage on said lands and that this plat made in accordance with this survey, is hereby adopted as a true and correct plat of said lands. All drives and easements for drainage, utilities and sewers are hereby irrevocably, without reservation, dedicated to the City of Jacksonville, its successors and assigns. The drainage easement through and over the lakes and filtration systems shown on this plat are hereby irrevocably dedicated to the City of Jacksonville, its successors and assigns and are subject to the following covenants which shall run with the land; (1) the drainage easements hereby dedicated shall permit the City of Jacksonville and its successors and assigns to discharge into said lakes and filtration systems which these easements traverse, all water which may fall on or come upon all drives hereby dedicated, together with all soils, nutrients, chemicals and all other substances which may flow or pass from drives and courts, from adjacent land, or from any other source of public waters into or through said lakes and filtration systems without any liability whatsoever on the part of the City of Jacksonville, its successors and assigns for any damages, injuries or losses to persons or property resulting from the acceptance or use of these drainage easements by the City of Jacksonville, its successors and assigns; (2) the lakes and filtration systems shown on this plat are owned in fee simple title by the abutting property owners; and the City of Jacksonville by acceptance of this plat assumes no responsibility for the removal or treatment of aquatic plants and animals, soil, chemicals or any other substance or thing that may even be or come within said lakes or filtration systems which these easements traverse, nor any responsibility for maintenance or preservation of the water purity, water level or water depth which responsibilities shall be those of the abutting owners, and; (3) the City of Jacksonville, its successors and assigns shall not be liable nor responsible for the creation, operation, failure or destruction of any water level control equipment which may be constructed or installed by the developer or any other person within the area of the lands hereby platted or of the lakes and filtration systems shown on this plat, but shall have the right to modify the existence of the lakes and filtration systems and that which retains it, to effect adequate drainage, including, but not limited to, the right to remove any water level control structures or any part thereof, Hutson, Sing Joint Venture IV, developer and owner of the lands described and captioned hereon, shall indemnify the City of Jacksonville and save it harmless from suits, actions, damages, liability and expense in connection with loss of life, bodily or personal injury, property damage or other damage arising from or out of any occurrence in, upon, or at, or from the lakes and filtration systems described above, or any part thereof, or occasioned wholly or in part by any act or omission of Hutson, Sing Joint Venture IV, its agents, contractors, employees, servants, licensees or concessionaires with CYPRESS HAMMOCK unit four. This indemnification shall run with the land and the assigns of Hutson, Sing Joint Venture IV, and shall be subject to it. The Jacksonville Electric Authority Easements as shown are dedicated to the Jacksonville Electric Authority and its successors for its use in its underground electric distribution system.
